

# The Medical Marijuana Program FACTS

- Patients in New York and New Jersey must be diagnosed with a qualifying medical condition in order to participate in the Medical Marijuana Program (MMP). (See Qualifying Conditions New York and Qualifying Conditions New Jersey.)
- Once the patient has completed the 'New Patient Registration Form' and forwarded the
  associated documents to our office, our counselors will establish a patient profile for the
  patient. This information will be shared with Dr. Kulik for his review prior to the patient's
  consultation.
- After all forms have been received, the patient will be contacted to schedule a consultation with Dr. Kulik.
- If the patient is medically approved for the MMP, a reference number will be issued to the patient, which is required to register with the State of New Jersey and/or the State of New York.

#### Following the Patient's Consultation with Dr. Kulik

Once the patient has been medically approved for the MMP and once the patient has received his or her registration number to participate in the program, the patient must register with the State of New Jersey or the State of New York.

#### Patients will:

- a. Enter the registration number provided by Dr. Kulik.
- b. Will upload to the New Jersey or New York State site a passport style photograph of the patient against a white, solid background (such as a wall.) Patients should not utilize hats or glasses in the photograph. This photograph will be used to generate the patient's identification card.
- c. Government issued ID, such as:
  - Current driver's license or
  - Current non-driver ID card
- d. Proof of Residency (PO Boxes are not accepted.)
  - Utility bill issued within the last 90-days which includes the patient's name and current address. Gas-Electric-Water-Sewer-Cell Phone-Cable(Television/Internet/Phone) bills are acceptable forms of utility bills.
  - Correspondence from the IRS within the last year.
  - Bank statements from the prior 3-month period.
- e. Reduced Card Fee Eligibility



• The registration fee for the State of New Jersey's program is \$100.00. The State of New York does not have a registration fee at this time. Please note: This fee is separate from Dr. Kulik's exam fee. Senior citizens, military veterans and those receiving certain forms of government assistance may be eligible for a reduced registration fee of \$20.00.

Once the patient has successfully registered their registration number with the State of New York or the State of New Jersey, the patient will receive an email stating their documents have been received and are under review. This may take between one (1) to two (2) weeks. The patient card will be mailed to the address provided to the State programs.

**Note:** The medical card in New Jersey is valid for two-years and the medical card for New York residents is one-year. When a patient's card expires, he or she will need to re-register their information and upload the same documents in order to renew their MMP card.

# Following the Patient Being Issued Their MMP Card

Once the patient has received their MMP card, the patient is able to visit dispensaries operating in their state. Patients may visit any dispensary, but it is always best for patients to schedule an appointment with the dispensary on their first visit.

New Jersey patients are required to contact our office every 90-days for a prescription renewal. New York patients can be certified for up to one-year.
